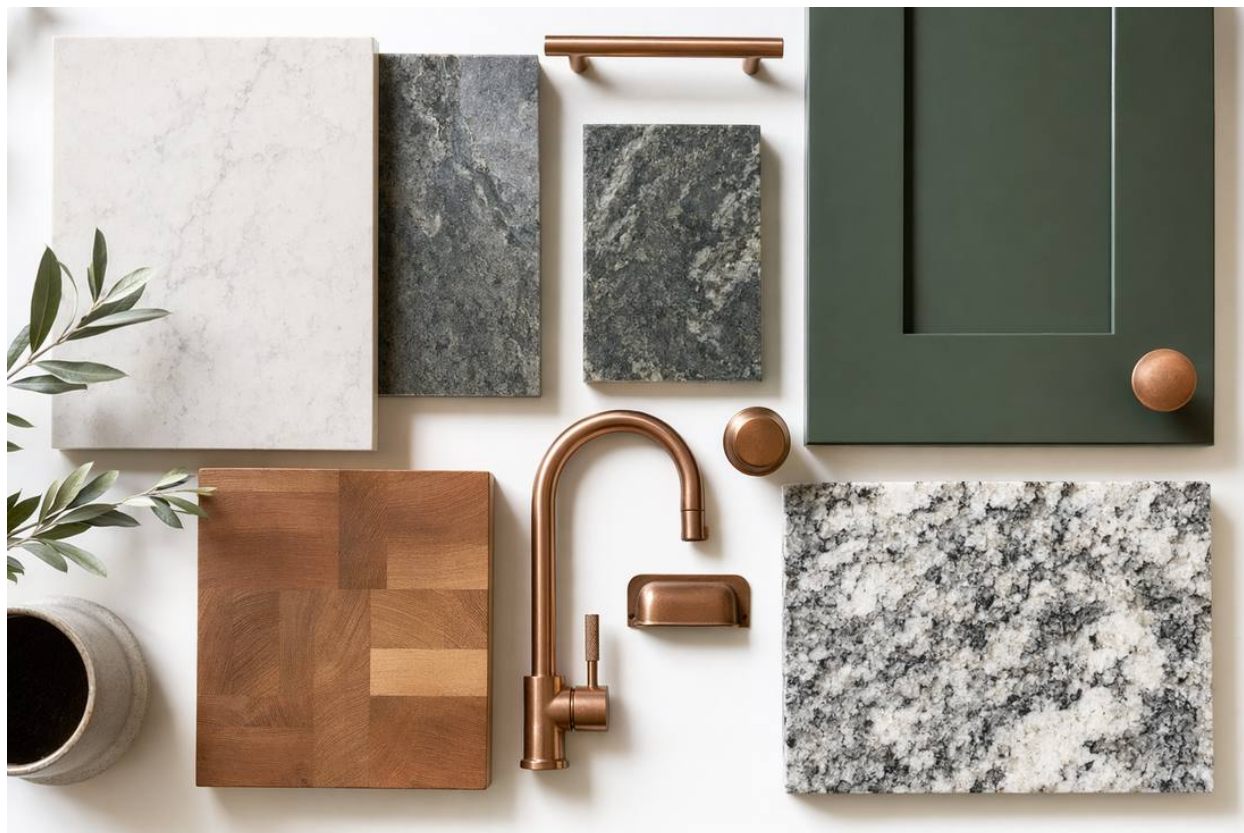

Compare kitchen remodel quotes line by line so you can tell a fair price from a padded one.



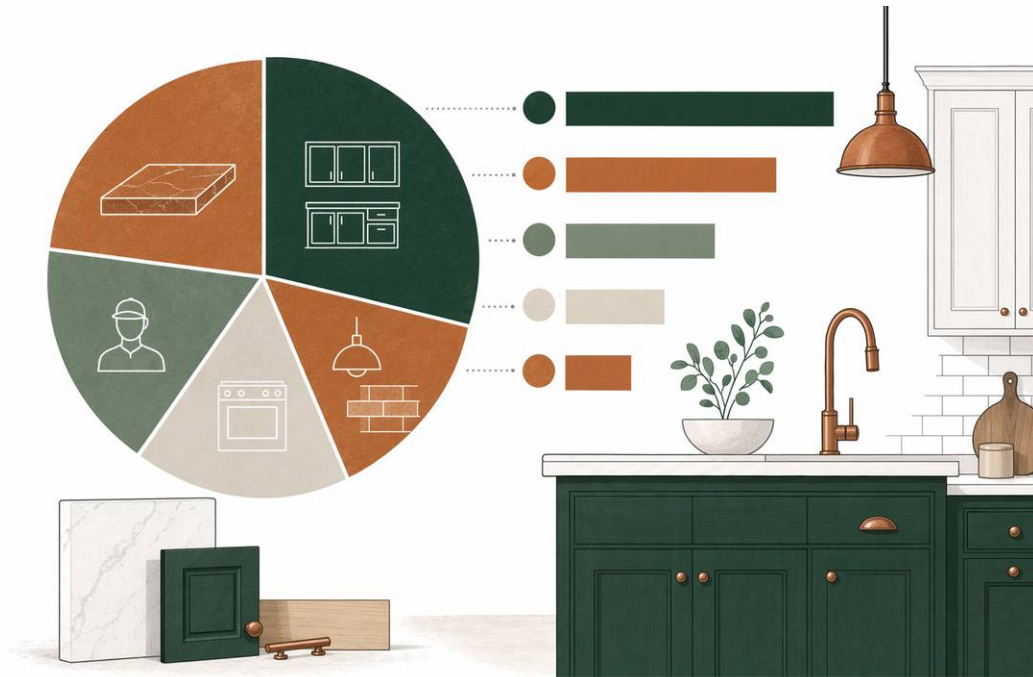
Plan your kitchen remodel with open eyes — then get matched, free, with licensed, insured remodelers near you. You compare quotes and choose who to hire.

Why the cheapest quote is rarely the real bill

Two quotes for 'a kitchen' can mean two very different projects. The gap is usually in what's left out. Compare like for like.

Line items to line up side by side

- Demolition and disposal
- Cabinets (tier, brand, and box construction)
- Countertops (material and square footage)
- Appliances and fixtures (who supplies them)
- Plumbing and electrical work
- Flooring, backsplash, and paint
- Permits, inspections, and cleanup

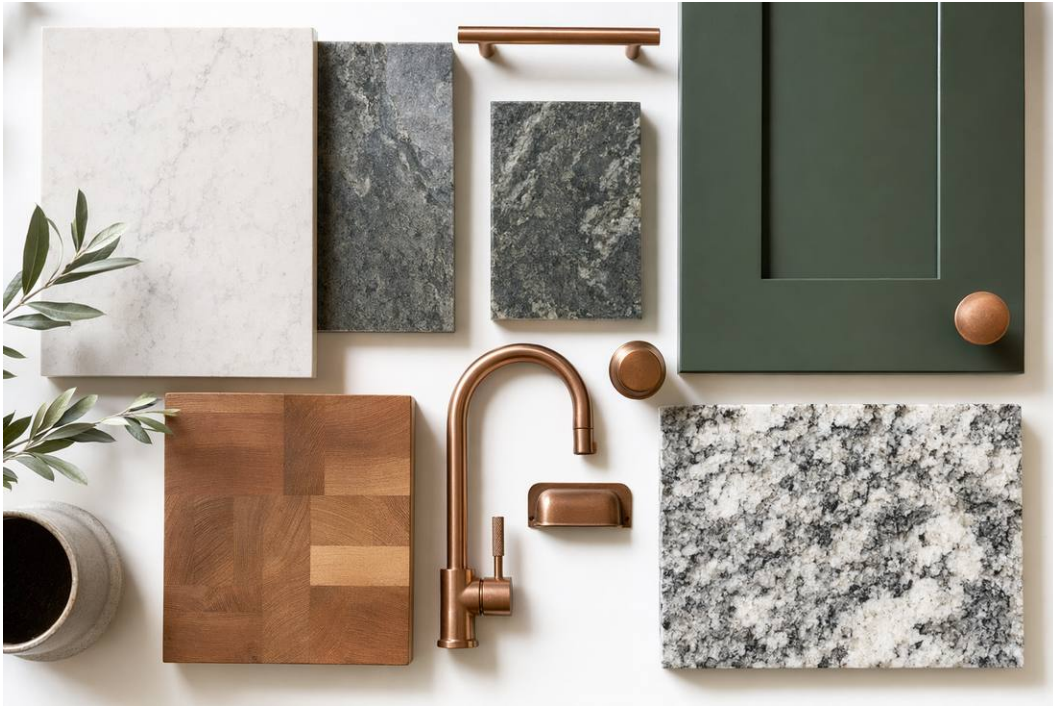


Questions that reveal the truth

- 1 What is NOT included in this number?
- 2 Is the permit cost inside or outside the quote?
- 3 What grade of cabinet and counter is assumed?
- 4 What happens to the price if there's hidden damage behind the walls?
- 5 When is each payment due, and tied to what milestone?

Score each quote

For each contractor, mark whether every line above is included, excluded, or unclear. The most complete quote — not the lowest — is usually the honest one.
